
Supplies


- 1. 8 ½ by 11-inch paper
- 2. Watercolors and/or crayons
- 3. Scotch tape

What to do:

Before starting: Paint a design on the paper using watercolors and let dry. Take a photo of the art you created.

- 1. Fold the paper in half vertically.
- 2. Unfold the paper and fold each of the top corners into the center line.
- 3. Fold the top edges into the center line.
- 4. Fold the plane in half toward you.
- 5. Fold the wings down, matching the top edges up with the bottom edge of the body.
- 6. Add double stick tape to the inside of the body. The finished plane should look like the photo below labeled 6.





Taking it further:

- Color a paper with crayons and make another airplane. Test which plane flies farther.
- Make a plane with plain paper and test how far it flies compared to the painted and crayon colored planes.
- Any difference in flight patterns? Height?
- Search online for other models of paper airplanes to make. Compare flight patterns, height and distance among the different models.
- Take a photo of your airplanes and post them with your "before" art to the library's Facebook page.
