
Activity Stations:

This portion of the program was passive. Children were invited to participate in any or all of the activities and spend as much time as they wanted at each table. Each table was equipped with a book on the topic, all of the materials required to do the activity and a description of what to do. Here are the descriptions we included:

Cutting: Grab a piece of paper and practice cutting on the line.



Alphabet: Grab a letter and stamp it on your paper. Can you tell its name? Do you know the sound it takes? What words contain that letter? Try another one!



Shapes/Colors: Pick a shape and try to name it. Do you know what color it is? Select several shapes and using the glue sticks, create a picture to take home with you.



Numbers: Select a bag and count the number of objects inside it. Can you match it with the numerals on the table?
