- 1. I was once a slave and I later started a secret, Blacks only Sunday school and taught children to read and write. Who am I? (Frederick Douglass)
- 2. I refused to give up my seat on a bus to a white person, and helped shine the national spotlight on segregation. Who am I? (Rosa Parks)
- 3. I was a civil rights lawyer who won 29 of the 30 cases I presented before the US Supreme Court, and I went on to become the first African American US Supreme Court Justice. Who am I? (Thurgood Marshall)
- 4. I was the first African American to play major league baseball, with the Brooklyn Dodgers in 1947. Who am I? (Jackie Robinson)
- 5. We were the first African Americans to win the Academy Award (Oscar) for Best Actor and Best Actress. Who are we? (Sidney Poitier, Halle Berry)
- 6. I graduated from Harvard, was the first African American to earn a doctorate, and I co-founded the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP). Who am I? (W.E.B. Du Bois)
- 7. I broke three world records in track and field in 45 minutes in 1935. Who am I? (Jesse Owens)
- 8. I was the first African American Secretary of State. Who am I? (Colin Powell)
- 9. I was the first African American to receive the Nobel Prize for Literature, in 1993. Who am I? (Toni Morrison)
- 10. I was a famous Civil Rights leader who wrote *Letter from a Birmingham Jail* and gave the 1963 speech, "I Have a Dream." Who am I? (Martin Luther King, Jr.)
- 11. I was the first African American congresswoman and the first major-party black candidate to make a bid for the U.S. presidency. Who am I? (Shirley Chisholm)
- 12. I flew on the *Endeavour* in 1992, becoming the first African American woman in space. Who am I? (Mae Jemison)
- 13. I was known as "The First Lady of Song" and was one of the top female jazz singers for over 50 years. Who am I? (Ella Fitzgerald)
- 14. I was well-known for my memoir *I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings*, and my poetry, one of which I recited at the 1993 inauguration of President Bill Clinton. Who am I? (Maya Angelou)
