By the end of the classes, they will have picked a product or service, created a business name and logo, learned money management, communication, and selling skills.

The tables will be set up near the Children's Library before the parade begins for the Gretna Days event. For kids who do not set a table but want to help, they will have the opportunity to help at the book sale at the main branch.

On June 20, we set up a Super Hero Bake Sale to kick off our classes.



# -----Session One: Starting a Business-----

## **Activity #1 – See worksheet**

For the first activity, we invite the kids to think of ideas for what they want to sell or trade for their business. Brainstorm a bunch of ideas. The ideas can be a product or a service. Then, decide on your best two ideas. For those two ideas, write down what you will need to make it happen. What do you need to buy and/or make to sell it on July 18? Ultimately, you will need to pick one idea and by creating a list of what you need for both ideas will help you to make the decision.

## **Activity #2 – See worksheet**

For the second activity, we ask the kids to think of some business names. Once they have picked a name, we showed examples of a business logo. We asked the kids to design their own logo. Examples are listed on the worksheet.

## **June 27 Class**

We will cover money management! We invite you to bring your activity #1 and 2 sheets back to the class. If you can, please research the cost of your supplies that you will need for your two best ideas.

**Parents:** you will need to let your kids know what their budget will be. The library can only supply the tables and poster board for the signs.

**Money on July 18:** the kids will need to bring their own money for change from their sales.

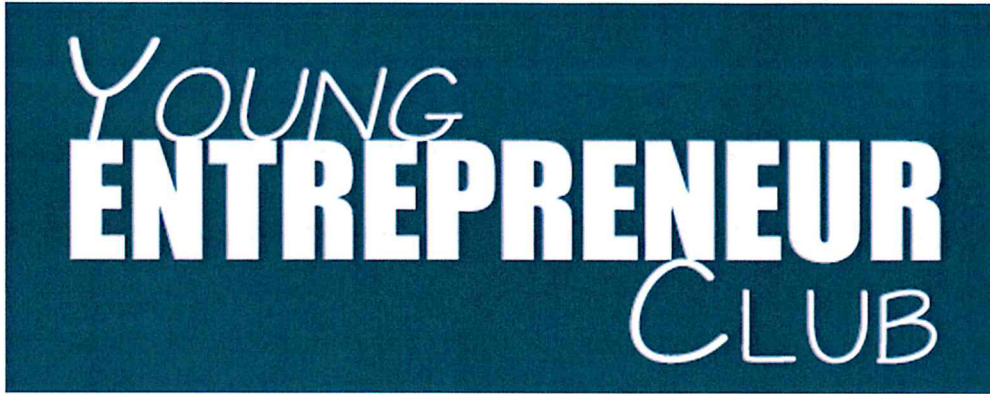


